1. ROBERT¹ HARVEY was born Abt. 1660 in Irishowen, Donagal County, No. Ireland, and died 1708. He married (1) AGNES TREDWAY. He married (2) ISABELL MCKAY.

Notes for ROBERT HARVEY:

Son, James Harvey, started genealogical entries in his family bible. Unfortunately, James Harvey did not record himself or his wife, and did not show his parents and exact place of birth. There are several possibilities of whom James,' John's and Francis' parents were (from Irish records) but nothing is certain. It is believed, however that the father is Robert Harvey, as shown.

Robert Harvey was a merchant of Londonderry and a tanner by trade. In Grahm's "Siege of Londonderry," his home was near Bishop's Gate outside the city walls. He was a Presbyterian Elder; his name is on the mural table of First Derry Presbyterian Church, according to author A. Burgess. He is the ancestor of Malin Hall Harvey's of Malin Head. Amy Young's "Three Hundred Years in Irishowen," page 121 states that the father of this Robert is John, not James, son of George Harvey who received confirmation of arms; and that the Malin Hall Harvey's lived at Keenagh, Malin Head, as far back as 1640; also that Robert married a "Miss Mc.Y."

2. JOHN² HARVEY (*ROBERT*¹) was born Abt. 1687 in (Prob) Londonderry, Londonderry, Northern Ireland, and died Bet. 1749 - 1750 in Nottingham, Rockingham, New Hampshire. He married ELIZABETH.

Notes for JOHN HARVEY:

Nottingham, New Hampshire, was incorporated in 1722, and the Harveys were among its earliest settlers. Coggsell says on page 76 of his "History of Nottingham, Deerfield and Northwood" that the Dearborns, Gilleys, Williams', McLearys and Harveys are names never to be forgotten or effaced from the pages of New Hampshire or American History; and from the "Revolutionary Rolls" published in volumes 14, 15, 16 and 17 of the "New Hampshire State Papers" we learn there were twenty-one Harveys in the Revolutionary war from that state.

There were two branches of the family in Nottingham. One branch was the descendants of JAMES, JOHN and FRANCIS HARVEY, and this was the "Scotch-Irish" branch. (This term is in recognition that originally many Northern Ireland Harveys lived in Scotland.) These three men settled in Nottingham about 1727. They came over from the North of Ireland during the "Scotch Irish" emigration from that country early in the eighteenth century, and after tarrying a short time in Londonderry, NH, pushed on into the wilderness and settled in the new town of Nottingham where they became prominent citizens as did many of their descendants. (See Coggsell's History and

also the book, "Notes on Early Harvey Families of New Hampshire" prepared by George Harvey of Sacramento, California.)

The other branch of the Harvey family in Nottingham were the descendants of JONATHAN HARVEY, who settled in the town in 1754. He was descended from WILLIAM HARVEY of Plymouth and Boston, Mass., and became the progenitor of the Harveys of Sutton and Northwood, NH. WILLIAM and THOMAS HARVEY came to this country at some time prior to 1640 and first settled in Plymouth, Mass., where WILLIAM married Joan Hucker, about 1639.

John Harvey had a brother, James Harvey [not totally confirmed], who came from Ireland on the same ship in 1726. His descendency is shown in the same George Harvey book and is scheduled in this present Family Tree Maker file.

George Harvey reports that, "Thomas, Jr., Francis, only ones [children of John Harvey] known to us and we are not certain which was the older." [In some references James is listed before John, suggesting that James is the older.] "Deeds: Francis & Thomas Harvey, Jr., Nottingham, yeomen, L100 [pounds] from Thomas Harvey, husbandman, 9 ac[res]...on land of Wm. Morrison and plot of land lately belonging to our honoured father, John Harvey, of Nottingham, deceased. 7 Feb 1750." [Date appears to be for the document, rather than John's death date.] "There are indications of a son John, but we have not identified one."

Administration of John's estate was given to Elizabeth (his wife) and Thomas Harvey (his first son) February 22, 1748/1749 according to New Hampshire Wills [&] Probate Records 12/328.

Much of the above information and that for some of John Harvey's descendents came from the privately published (25 copies) publication, "Notes on Early Harvey Families of New Hampshire," prepared by George Harvey of Sacramento, CA, dated December, 1979. (See book Reference 929.273, H262hg in the LDS Family History Library.)

Londonderry, No. Ireland per Encyclopedia Britannica:

"St. Columba established a monastery on the site in the middle of the 6th century, but the settlement was destroyed by Norse invaders, who reportedly burned it down seven times before 1200. Later the town served as a strategic point in the Tudor wars against the native Irish. In 1600 an English force seized Derry, demolishing Irish churches and the monastery. Shortly thereafter (in 1613), James I of England granted Derry to the citizens of London who laid out the new city, built stout walls, and brought in Protestant (both English and Scots) settlers. The place was thereafter officially known as Londonderry. The new city was unsuccessfully besieged several times in the 17th century, particularly by the forces of James II in 1688-89. Londonderry served as a naval base during World Wars I and II; its contemporary port facilities, however, are of minor importance. A civil rights campaign seeking equal rights for Roman Catholics was inaugurated in Ulster in 1968, and in 1969 street violence occurred in Londonderry. Intermittent disturbances into the 1980s were characterized by the ongoing use of firearms and bombs."

There is only limited, speculative information concerning this possible son.

3. JAMES² HARVEY (*ROBERT*¹) was born Abt. 1693 in (Prob)Londonderry, Londonderry,Northern Ireland, and died 04 May 1742 in Nottingham, Rockingham, New Hampshire. He married ANN MAXWELL, daughter of JAMES MAXWELL. She was born Abt. 1689 in (/) Londonderry, Londonderry, Northern Ireland.

Notes for JAMES HARVEY:

James Harvey and his family sailed from Portrush, Antrim, No. Ireland on August 7, 1726, and landed in Boston, Mass. on October 8, 1726, and thence to Haverhill November 26, 1726, and then to Derry on April 19, 1727. They moved to Nottingham, NH at least by 1729-1730. This James appears to be the one who, along with his apparent

brother, John, signed the oath of allegiance to the king on October 9, 1727 in Londonderry, NH.

The following Harvey names appear on the Coulrain Charter dated December 1, 1726, (a petition for settling a new plantation/town called, Coulrain, near Rochester, NH.): James Harvey, John Harvey, Robert Harvey, Jonathin Harvey Sr., John Harvey Jr., Franacis Harvey, and Thomas Harvey.

According to, "Irish Immigrants to Colonial New England, Personal Notes compiled by George Harvey," the following families emigrated with James Harvey in the same ship from Portrush in 1726: Andrew McClary; John and Daniel McCrellis; Robert and William Kelsey; Robert McCurdy; Andrew McCutcheson; Neal McCaw; James Maxwell; David, Hugh, James and William Morrison; Andrew Wealty; Thomas Simpson; James Harvey (John Harvey's brother).

4. THOMAS³ HARVEY JR (*JOHN² HARVEY, ROBERT¹*) was born in Nottingham, Rockingham, New Hampshire, and died Bet. 1773 - 1777. He married ABIGAIL DARLING Abt. 1760 in Nottingham, Rockingham, New Hampshire, daughter of STACY DARLING and SARAH PEAVY. She was born Abt. 1744 in Prob. New Hampshire, and died 30 May 1814.

Notes for THOMAS HARVEY JR:

Thomas, son of Thomas, Jr., stated he was about eight when his father died. Administration of the estate to widow Abigail March 26, 1777 (NH Probate 23/510--VS). Thomas, Jr., was so-called possibly because in the Nottingham area at the time Thomas (Robert, James) was living. Almost all of the information on this Thomas, Jr., line is from the incomplete work of VS, Abigail married 20 James Magner.

Children: Thomas, Jr. and Francis are the only children known. There is uncertainty of which one is the older. ("Deed 85/39, NH Prov. Deeds: Francis & Thomas Harvey, Jr., Nottingham, yoemen, L100 [pounds] from Thomas Harvey, husbandman, 9 acres... on land of Wm. Morrison and plot of land lately belonging to our honoured father, John Harvey of Nottingham, deceased. 7 Feb 1750. There are indications of a son John, but we have not identified one.)"

Notes for MEHITABLE LADD:
Removed from Nottingham to Winthrop, Maine, probably as early as 1797, with wife and two sons. Lived by 1805 at Harvey Corners. They bought land and built a two-story house at Harvey Corners (later owned by Charles B. Stanton).

Samuel brooded over the death of his wife so much that he built a capacious tomb near his house. Mehitable and others were buried there, the last being Julia Ann (Dexter) Ladd who died July 11, 1899. The tomb was then sealed.

Robert and Thomas were two of the grantees of Holderness, NH, 1751. Some of Robert's children were baptised by Church of England minister of Queen's Chapel, Portsmouth.

8. THOMAS⁴ HARVEY (*THOMAS³ HARVEY JR, JOHN² HARVEY, ROBERT¹*) was born Nov 1765 in Nottingham, Rockingham, New Hampshire, and died 23 Jun 1849 in Randolph, Cattaraugus, New York. He married SABRA (SARAH) (UNKNOWN).

Notes for THOMAS HARVEY:

Following information was from "Notes on Early Harvey Families of New Hampshire; prepared by George Harvey, PO Box 60671, Sacramento, CA, 95860. Published December, 1979.

Thomas left Nottingham about 1789 or before. He lived in Floyd, Oneida County, New York, or at least owned land there. Thomas then moved to Ashtabula, Ashtabula County, Ohio. He moved to Michigan about 1837. Thomas was in the Revolutionary War and his pension papers said that he was a cousin of James Harvey and that his home was 1 1/2 miles from Nottingham Square Center (Pension No. S 18008). Thomas signed a deed to Simon Ladd in Nottingham in 1788. He disliked his step-father calling him a drunken Irishman. His pension application was from Ashtabula County, Ohio, dated November 6, 1845; he was 70 then.

All his family moved west except John. Thomas was blind the last seven years of his life. Although Thomas enlisted January 1, 1779 from Pembroke, now Concord, New Hampshire, he was actually a resident of Nottingham in 1778. He served in the New Hampshire line in Capt. Hutchinson's company, a part of Col. Crilly regiment, until the end of the war. He was discharged at West Point, New York. Thomas also served at Saratoga and New Jersey. Thomas stated that he had lost contact with his brothers and sisters and it had been over 60 years since he last saw them. He became a Methodist in New York and was quite active in that church. His daughter, Harriet, married a Methodist minister. Thomas is not shown in the DAR Index. It is believed that his wife Sarah's second marriage was to Gilbert Barnet.

When Thomas died, three of his ten children survived him.

George Harvey's book states that James was in the Revolutionary War; in 1809 testified that he was in Waterborough, Maine, in 1768 hauling logs for Mr. Samuel Baker; had transferred property in Nottingham to brother-in-law Joshua Stevens, April 1767; sold his share of his father's estate for L10 [pounds], April 4, 1767; estate divided January 4, 1811. His residence was Waterborough, Maine.

The books of the Holland Land Co furnish a list of landowners in 1821; Thomas Harvey.

In 1822, H. S. Latham, from Long Island, located on lot 31, where he purchased five acres for the purpose of establishing a tannery. He built the first frame house in town, and commenced work on his tannery, but sold out to Thomas Harvey before he got it fully in operation.

In April, 1822, Thomas Harvey located on the Fuller property. He had a family of 6 daughters and several sons. The former came with their husbands, named James Orton and William Miner, but all removed to the West. Two of his daughters married David Salisbury and Clement Russell, also early settlers, in 1824, and these were the first marriages in town. (my note-Sabra Harvey m Clement Russell.)

Edmund Fuller sold his interests in 1822 to Thomas Harvey, who also came from Oneida. (This was lot 31).

James Powell settled on lot 32 in 1823, and there built a house which is still standing. (1879) A brother, Dennis, lived on lot 40. Both moved to Pennsylvania. (This would be after 1833 when Richard Salisbury left a will leaving any pension money forthcoming to James Powell, his son in law, with whom he had been living with for several years. See "Notes for Richard Salisbury.")

In conformity with the provisions of the act of the legislature of Feb. 1, 1826, the voters assembled on Mar 7 to hold their first meeting. Thomas Harvey was chosen moderator. Among the officers elected; Poormaster--James Powell. In 1827 and 1828 Thomas Harvey was elected Supervisor. In 1827 Thomas Harvey was Justice of the Peace.

The first manufacturing enterprise in the present town of Randolph was a saw-mill put up by Thomas Harvey in 1823. It stood on Dry Brook. in the western part of the village, and was operated about a dozen years, then abandoned as the stream was too feeble at this point to be employed.

In early times, Thomas Harvey had a small tannery, and after it was discontinued Miner (?son-in-law) and Latham carried on a tannery of greater capacity for a number of years.

Present Randolph village (1879) is situated on the west bank of Little Connewango Creek on land which was originally owned by Edmund Fuller, Jacob Vandawaker, Thomas Harvey and Abraham Bush.

Randolph Methodist Episcopal Church meetings were held as early as 1823 at the homes of Thomas Harvey and others, but the names of the members cannot be learned.

ADDISON HARVEY: The subject of the present sketch, Addison Harvey, was the son of Thomas and Sabra Harvey, and was born in Oneida County, New York, August 21, 1814. He was one of a family of ten children, of whom he alone survives. He left Oneida County when but eight years old, in company with his father's family, removing to Cattaraugus County in the same state where he resided until 1837, when he immigrated to Michigan in the month of September of that year, making the journey with an ox-team, and being twenty-seven days on the road. He purchased his present location on his arrival in Leonidas, St. Joseph County, on which there was a small log house and about one acre enclosed. Mr. Harvey began life as a poor boy, but by industry and frugality, is now, in his old age, the owner of one of the best farms in Leonidas, containing four hundred and thirty-six acres. The homestead of one hundred and fifty-six acres is finely improved, with large barns and a comfortable dwelling thereon, a view of which we present on another page of our work. In the spring of 1835, Mr. Harvey was united in marriage with Miss Anna Beadle, by whom two sons were born to him--James and Addison, Jr., the latter dying when about a year old. Mrs. Harvey died in the fall of 1837, and now sleeps in the cemetery near Leonidas village. In November, 1842, Mr. Harvey took to himself another companion--Miss Amer E. Hall, of Ashtabula, Ohio. Three children were the fruits of this union--Sophia, Elizabeth A. and Porter S. of whom Elizabeth only survives. On the 3rd day of April, Mrs. Harvey passed to her rest, leaving the husband once more alone. On the 8th day of September, Mr. Harvey, finding a lonely life unendurable, brought a companion to share and brighten his desolate home. She was Miss Maria Teller, a daughter of Tobias Teller, of Saratoga County, New York, with whom she came to Michigan, November 10, 1843. Mr. Harvey was originally a member of the Whig party, and joined the Republican cause when that party was organized. He has been a prominent man in his younger days, and has held the offices of supervisor and justice of the peace for several years. Not having in his youth had very good advantages for an education, he has given his children all the advantages he was able to for a good one. Mr. Harvey's father was a Revolutionary soldier and lived to a good old age.

In Iowa, they lived in a hotel (Milliard Hotel destroyed by a tornado in 1860) with Harry, one year old. In 1870, another son, Earl, is shown. Squire is now a liquor sales agent. Squire is listed in a 1884 Chicago City Directory in a business known as Squire T. Harvey & Son, 185 Washington, Chicago. Harry and Squire are shown with a home at 609 West Monroe. Squire died April 25, 1902 at his residence [1159 Wilcox]. This is recorded in the Chicago Journal newspaper April 16, 1902.

"July 31, 1998, I [Addison James Harvey, Jr.] went by Clinton, Iowa. I visited the city library, county court house and the county administration office. The latter, I visited the Recorders Office and asked for marriage certificates. The lady showed me the index for 1858. I found S T Harvey and A L Sessions filing for a certificate on July 23, 1858. They were married on July 26, 1858 by Rev J G Dimmitt. The parents and the bride and groom were not recorded at that time."

Squire's business address was 153 S. Washington in Chicago. When Amanda died in 1900, Squire moved to an apartment at 4241 Ashland in Chicago. The 1900 Federal Census then lists Squire at 1159 Wilcox, but as a boarder and Anna Pierce as "head" of household. She was born ten years after Squire. She is buried in the family plot, as stated. Her relationship to the Harvey's or the Sessions', if any, is unknown.

Squire Earl Rowe (Harvey), Celebration of Life
(October 4, 1998; Portland, Oregon)

Welcome to all of you and thanks for coming today. My name is Thomas Harvey and Earl was my half-brother. We had the same father, whom Earl was named after: Squire Earl Harvey. I am very thankful to Virginia that this gathering is a "Celebration of Life" for my brother - rather than just another tearful funeral. I am offering some background information, and I am doing this with Earl's own words. Earl wrote this biography in September of 1971, in a letter to my sisters, Charlotte and Lenore. I will read this letter. I am sure that there will be things none of you knew before. I guarantee that all of you will find this account very fascinating. You will find some parts inspirational. I made some extra copies, so please let me know if you would like one.

"Sept. 9, 1971

"Dear Lenore & Charlotte,

"How do you take 56 years and put them down on paper. I too found out about you when somebody mailed the newspaper clipping [about Lenore & Charlotte's championship swimming] to me. I didn't know about Tom until recently when I wrote a letter to the mortuary requesting a list of the relatives at our father's funeral. In fact, I knew so little about our father and my mother's marriage and divorce that I decided it was about time to dig up all the information I could. I contacted all the State and Government agencies and researched the information I needed and that led to breaking the ice for our mutual contact.

"I have old letters from our father and one from Grandma Harvey, but I was never able to get a picture of our father.

"I was about 8 or 9 when mother told me Rowe wasn't my real father and as I recall the only shock was the knowledge that my brothers and sister were only half brothers and sister. I never looked at my stepfather as a stepfather, but it must have done something to me, because from then on I wanted to pay my own way. It also made me very protective of my kid brother. If anyone picked on him, I proceeded to whip them. I was that way until he died at the age of 12 ½ from meningitis.

"In Junior High School I scored the highest points in athletics and graduated at 14.

"The day I was to enter Senior High I came down with meningitis and at that time, it was 98% fatal. There was an epidemic in Salt Lake at that time, it was a horribly painful disease, and they injected a horse serum into your spine and that made the pain worse. It also caused allergic reactions that were terrible, but I made my mind up I would not scream and yell like the rest of the patients were doing so I put a corner of the pillow in my mouth and chewed on it. In moments of consciousness, I always did that.

"I remember hearing the doctor tell my mother that I couldn't live till morning and her anguish was almost more than I could bear. She couldn't come into my room, but I hollered to her that he was wrong and I promised her I wouldn't die.

"What went on after that if I hadn't made that promise I would have died. When the day came to go home I couldn't use my legs and my neck was stiff. Final verdict week later was I would never walk again. I said to myself I'll prove them wrong again.

"I think I wished life back into my legs, and I sat in that wheel chair and rubbed and rubbed my legs and months later I knew life was coming back and one night I slid out of that chair and I halfway stood on my feet. I screamed "I can stand! I can stand!" and the family came rushing into my room thinking something horrible had happened.

"I made steady progress so about a year later I was almost well when we moved to Calif. A few months then we moved to Portland, Ore. I was almost entirely well, then bang! I developed Osteo of the spine from the spinal punctures. Paralyzed again only worse. Spinal operations, leg operation - finally six months to live [and] no hope from the doctors. This happened six weeks (that is the start) before graduation from Senior High. Again I said to myself I'll prove them wrong.

"Off came the body cast and brace and believe it or not I had my chums take me out to the Columbia River and dropped me in. My operation was not even healed completely. Another miracle; the swimming, the sunshine, the physical drive I put my body to cured me.

"I went to work and paid all of those horrible hospital and doctor bills, although it took me years to do it. I paid them in full. I wouldn't let my stepfather pay them.

"I worked twelve hours a day, six to six and night school 6:45 to 9:30. I didn't get a degree because I wasn't after that; I was after knowledge.

"Under the adult education program, I received the certificate in Abnormal Psychology, General Psychology, Adolescent Psychology, and Mental Hygiene. I took a term at Oregon Extension in Accounting. At OIT I took English and Sociology. I took a course in Spanish and several courses in investing.

"I bought a cabin cruiser during the war had [was?]in the Coast Guard [Auxiliary?] during the war and completed a course in navigation. Also took up flying.

"I purchased two taverns, one in Jan. 1, 1940, and the other in April 1942. From Jan. 1, 1940 til April of 1950, I worked every single day - not one day off.

"I worked hard and invested my money and for that reason, I was able to retire five years ago [1966]. Most of my investments have been very good to me, but about five years ago I suddenly realized there is more to life than getting more dollars.

"My writing is terrible and I know this sounds very egotistical, but it will give you something of my past. I could go and tell you for pages some of the things that have happened to me, but they would sound as far out as the above does. I have been in situations and accidents where, by all that is holy, I shouldn't have survived and almost every time I didn't get scratched. If there are guardian angels, I must have a flock of them.

"Incidentally, and I don't know why, perhaps it was loyalty to my stepfather, I asked few questions about our father; but the few times it came up my mother had nothing but good to say about him. I few months ago I called my Aunt Ruth up and she spoke very highly about him. In other words, it makes me feel good that nobody tried to cut him down.

"When things get back to normal from putting Virginia's mother in a rest home, I should be able to fly or drive back and see all of you. I especially want to meet your mother and Aunt Kay [Earl's

father's sister] because I will be forever indebted to them for our contact. I can't explain it but I feel a fondness for your mother like I had known her for years.

"Enclosed are a few slides and I will take some more so you will have something up-to-date. Again I hope this doesn't sound too egotistical or morbid, but it was a big chapter in my life and if you ever go swimming you will know why I have so many scars on my anatomy. Also, don't ever get the idea that it was all pain and hard work and study, because it wasn't. If I didn't love the hard work I wouldn't have done it and the same goes for study. Pain when it ends is soon forgotten. You can't appreciate life unless you love it; you can't appreciate your body unless it is almost wasted away. What you get by hard work or by your own ability you appreciate much more than if it was handed to you. Until I put this resume down on paper, whenever my thoughts drifted back it was always of the friends I made along the way, the fun I had and the thrill of besting some of the situations I was in.

"Well it is time to feed my birds and myself so until the next time the best of everything to all of you.

"Love, Brother Earl."
