"Abraham Samson, a brother of Henry Samson(\*) spoken of in the introduction [Genealogical Memoirs of the Samson Family], was the first in our line of descent, coming from England in the year 1629 or 30. He settled in Duxbury, formerly called Bridgewater, and was on the list of persons 'Able to Bear Arms' in 1643. That list included all able bodied males between the ages of sixteen and sixty. He was one of the original fifty-four grantees of Bridgewater in 1645, all of whom then resided in Duxbury. He was Surveyor of Highways in 1648; Constable in 1653; and was admitted Freeman of Plymouth Colony in 1654. His wife was a daughter of Samuel Nash by whom he had several Children."

(\*) Note: Abraham Samson and Henry Samson being brothers seems more grounded in folklore than in confirmed genealogy. They could possibly still be brothers -- or cousins -- however.

Middlebury, born probably about 1737, was put under guardianship by the court in 1750, after the death of his father, when about fourteen years of age. His great grandson, Calvin T. Samson, says, he was in the French and Indian War and was in the battle on the Monongahela, when Braddock was defeated, July 9, 1755. He also says that Jacob served through the Revolutionary War. Previous to that war he settled in New Salem in the old County of Hampshire, Mass., where he probably passed the remainder of his life. I find no record as to his wife. His sons were Jacob, George, Clark Samuel and Liscom, the last two were twins. His daughters, [were] Deborah, Elsie, Betsy and Polly. Deborah married Seneca Robinson. Polly married Trystam Aldridge." Caleb Samson was born in New Salem, Mass., January 19, 1792. When fourteen years of age he moved to Stamford, Vermont. He married Fanny Raze, May 2, 1814. In 1822, He removed with his family to Leroy, Genesee County, New York, where they resided until 1837. In the Fall of that year the family, at that time consisting of husband and wife, sons, Erastus and Edward, and daughters Harriet and Mary, moved to Peoria, Illinois. They resided there until the Fall of 1839 and then moved to Ypsilanti, Michigan. Caleb died in Ypsilanti on December 10, 1872, at the advanced age of 80 years, 10 months and 21 days. His wife was born in Stamford, Vermont, January 21, 1792, and died in Ypsilanti, April 28, 1863, aged 76 years, 3 months and 7 days. In conversation with Father Caleb and his sister, Phebe, they told me [Erastus Samson] that their great great grandmother's name was Alden; that Alden was murdered by a highwayman who came up behind him and struck him with a stone. She afterwards lived a widow; let her son have the property for her support. He thinks also that his grandfather died at toe age of 92.

According to "Genealogical Death Indexing System, Michigan" (GENDIS), Caleb died of "Typhoid Pneumonia." Birth date & place, Marriage Place and death date were the same as it the account above. Caleb's occupation was stated to be a "cooper."

learn the jewelry trade of his brother, Russel. He subsequently came back to Ypsilanti, remained about three years, and thence to Saline one year, and in 1854 moved to Marian, Linn County, Iowa [in 1890]. He was married in May, 1859, to Mrs. Kate N. Carter (Catherine Briggs?), a widow with one child named Cora Blanche, who married B. C. Busby, Jul (Feb?) 6, 1878. (This data extracted from "Genealogical Memoirs of the Samson Family" by Erastus Samson, 1890.)

Biographical sketch quoted from "The History of Linn County, Iowa", published in Chicago by Chapman Brothers, 1878 (page 630, Marion City):

"Samson, Edward L.- Watchmaker & manufacturing jeweler; born in Leroy N.Y., Feb. 7, 1832; came to Peoria Ill in 1838; lived there one year, then removed to Michigan, where he lived until he was 13 years of age; he then returned to Leroy, N.Y. where he remained four years and learned the jewelers trade; then returned to Michigan, where he resided four or five years; came to Marion, Iowa, Oct. 4, 1854; has resided here ever since [book dated 1878], excepting eighteen months that he spent in New York City, in 1860 and 1861. He has been City Treasurer [Mar. 1875], etc. Married Catherine M. Carter, in Rock Island, Ill, May 26, 1859; her maiden name was Kate M. Briggs; she was married to Charles C. Carter Nov 6, 1854 and came to Marion that year. Mr. Samson's children are Bertha Alice, born July 16, 1866; Laura L. [Lenore], July 19, 1868 and Roy E, February 3, 1873; they lost two - Charles E, born March 26, 1861, died Dec 22, 1866, and Josephine, born Sept. 11, 1864, and died Oct. 16, 1864. Mr. Samson is a member of the Congregational Church."

"Mrs. Bertha S. Green died Saturday evening [1/27/40] at her home, 83 Virginia St. after an illness of two years. She was born at Marian, Iowa and came to Salt Lake with her first husband, Earl T. Harvey in 1896. She had been active in club work and the First Congregational Church. She was a member of the PEO Sisterhood. Her second husband, W.L. Green died five years ago. Surviving are two sons, Edward S. Harvey and S. Earl Harvey of Salt Lake City; a daughter, Mrs. W.G. Wood of Salt Lake City and six grandchildren.

"Funeral services will be conducted Tuesday at 3:00 PM at 374 E 1st South Street by the Rev. George J. Weber. pastor of the First Congregational Church. Burial will be in Mt. Olivet Cemetery. Friends may call at the place of funeral Monday evening and Tuesday until time of services."

[Note that Bertha fell at her home getting out of a car, broke her hip and died of pneumonia. She had then been sick for an extended period of time, as noted above.]

Squire Earl Rowe (Harvey), Celebration of Life  
(October 4, 1998; Portland, Oregon)

Welcome to all of you and thanks for coming today. My name is Thomas Harvey and Earl was my half-brother. We had the same father, whom Earl was named after: Squire Earl Harvey. I am very thankful to Virginia that this gathering is a "Celebration of Life" for my brother - rather than just another tearful funeral. I am offering some background information, and I am doing this with Earl's own words. Earl wrote this biography in September of 1971, in a letter to my sisters, Charlotte and Lenore. I will read this letter. I am sure that there will be things none of you knew before. I guarantee that all of you will find this account very fascinating. You will find some parts inspirational. I made some extra copies, so please let me know if you would like one.

"Sept. 9, 1971

"Dear Lenore & Charlotte,

"How do you take 56 years and put them down on paper. I too found out about you when somebody mailed the newspaper clipping [about Lenore & Charlotte's championship swimming] to me. I didn't know about Tom until recently when I wrote a letter to the mortuary requesting a list of the relatives at our father's funeral. In fact, I knew so little about our father and my mother's marriage and divorce that I decided it was about time to dig up all the information I could. I contacted all the State and Government agencies and researched the information I needed and that led to breaking the ice for our mutual contact.

"I have old letters from our father and one from Grandma Harvey, but I was never able to get a picture of our father.

"I was about 8 or 9 when mother told me Rowe wasn't my real father and as I recall the only shock was the knowledge that my brothers and sister were only half brothers and sister. I never looked at my stepfather as a stepfather, but it must have done something to me, because from then on I wanted to pay my own way. It also made me very protective of my kid brother. If anyone picked on him, I proceeded to whip them. I was that way until he died at the age of 12 ½ from meningitis.

"In Junior High School I scored the highest points in athletics and graduated at 14.

"The day I was to enter Senior High I came down with meningitis and at that time, it was 98% fatal. There was an epidemic in Salt Lake at that time, it was a horribly painful disease, and they injected a horse serum into your spine and that made the pain worse. It also caused allergic reactions that were terrible, but I made my mind up I would not scream and yell like the rest of the patients were doing so I put a corner of the pillow in my mouth and chewed on it. In moments of consciousness, I always did that.

"I remember hearing the doctor tell my mother that I couldn't live till morning and her anguish was almost more than I could bear. She couldn't come into my room, but I hollered to her that he was wrong and I promised her I wouldn't die.

"What went on after that if I hadn't made that promise I would have died. When the day came to go home I couldn't use my legs and my neck was stiff. Final verdict week later was I would never walk again. I said to myself I'll prove them wrong again.

"I think I wished life back into my legs, and I sat in that wheel chair and rubbed and rubbed my legs and months later I knew life was coming back and one night I slid out of that chair and I halfway stood on my feet. I screamed "I can stand! I can stand!" and the family came rushing into my room thinking something horrible had happened.

"I made steady progress so about a year later I was almost well when we moved to Calif. A few months then we moved to Portland, Ore. I was almost entirely well, then bang! I developed Osteo of the spine from the spinal punctures. Paralyzed again only worse. Spinal operations, leg operation - finally six months to live [and] no hope from the doctors. This happened six weeks (that is the start) before graduation from Senior High. Again I said to myself I'll prove them wrong.

"Off came the body cast and brace and believe it or not I had my chums take me out to the Columbia River and dropped me in. My operation was not even healed completely. Another miracle; the swimming, the sunshine, the physical drive I put my body to cured me.

"I went to work and paid all of those horrible hospital and doctor bills, although it took me years to do it. I paid them in full. I wouldn't let my stepfather pay them.

"I worked twelve hours a day, six to six and night school 6:45 to 9:30. I didn't get a degree because I wasn't after that; I was after knowledge.

"Under the adult education program, I received the certificate in Abnormal Psychology, General Psychology, Adolescent Psychology, and Mental Hygiene. I took a term at Oregon Extension in Accounting. At OIT I took English and Sociology. I took a course in Spanish and several courses in investing.

"I bought a cabin cruiser during the war had [was?]in the Coast Guard [Auxiliary?] during the war and completed a course in navigation. Also took up flying.

"I purchased two taverns, one in Jan. 1, 1940, and the other in April 1942. From Jan. 1, 1940 til April of 1950, I worked every single day - not one day off.

"I worked hard and invested my money and for that reason, I was able to retire five years ago [1966]. Most of my investments have been very good to me, but about five years ago I suddenly realized there is more to life than getting more dollars.

"My writing is terrible and I know this sounds very egotistical, but it will give you something of my past. I could go and tell you for pages some of the things that have happened to me, but they would sound as far out as the above does. I have been in situations and accidents where, by all that is holy, I shouldn't have survived and almost every time I didn't get scratched. If there are guardian angels, I must have a flock of them.

"Incidentally, and I don't know why, perhaps it was loyalty to my stepfather, I asked few questions about our father; but the few times it came up my mother had nothing but good to say about him. I few months ago I called my Aunt Ruth up and she spoke very highly about him. In other words, it makes me feel good that nobody tried to cut him down.

"When things get back to normal from putting Virginia's mother in a rest home, I should be able to fly or drive back and see all of you. I especially want to meet your mother and Aunt Kay [Earl's father's sister] because I will be forever indebted to them for our contact. I can't explain it but I feel a fondness for your mother like I had known her for years.

"Enclosed are a few slides and I will take some more so you will have something up-to-date. Again I hope this doesn't sound too egotistical or morbid, but it was a big chapter in my life and if you ever

go swimming you will know why I have so many scars on my anatomy. Also, don't ever get the idea that it was all pain and hard work and study, because it wasn't. If I didn't love the hard work I wouldn't have done it and the same goes for study. Pain when it ends is soon forgotten. You can't appreciate life unless you love it; you can't appreciate your body unless it is almost wasted away. What you get by hard work or by your own ability you appreciate much more than if it was handed to you. Until I put this resume down on paper, whenever my thoughts drifted back it was always of the friends I made along the way, the fun I had and the thrill of besting some of the situations I was in.

"Well it is time to feed my birds and myself so until the next time the best of everything to all of you.

"Love, Brother Earl."
